Lakhdeep Singh has a passion and purpose for front line leadership in the field DEI focusing on Anti-Racism, Human Rights, Equity & Inclusion. He has worked with school boards across North America during New Teacher Induction Programs in both public and private schools. Recent projects include Indigenous Themed Logos in Township Facilities, 12 calls to Action on Reconciliation, and 2023 Hate Crime Report working with Ottawa Police Service, Toronto Police Service, York Police Service, and Peel Police Service focused on transparency in reporting standards and protocols that promote the dignity and respect of all. Lakhdeep Singh is a seasoned instructor with experience at Conestoga College for 6 years in the School of Community Services across numerous disciplines including early childhood education, social service worker, and criminal justice programs.

Upon completion of a master's degree in education, Lakhdeep Singh went on to become certified as an International Language Instructor. He has held various positions in academia such as Elementary School Teacher, Language Assessment Officer, ESL Teacher, College Instructor, and IELTS Invigilator.

In 2011, Lakhdeep Singh authored a proposal to the community capital fund of the Ontario Trillium Foundation where 60 submissions saw only 21 awarded. The result was the largest in Ontario history and the Trillium Foundation's half million-dollar grant became the catalyst for building construction of Sri Guru Singh Sabha in Cambridge, Ontario.

Lakhdeep's recent roles in the field of DEI include Vice President of Equity Education with unlearn, Program Facilitator with The Mosaic Institute, Chief Diversity Officer at Milton Public Library, and more recently he accepted the role of Chief Diversity and Inclusion Officer at Pearl Street Communications. He is a soccer fan, player and coach that is dedicated to the game and is known to score goals with his head and his feet!
